

Team Taylor from Twickenham smash Three Peaks Challenge for the British Skin Foundation

Father and daughter duo, Colin, & Hayley Taylor have completed the gruelling Three Peaks Challenge, climbing Ben Nevis, Scafell Pike and Snowdon in 24 hours. They smashed their fundraising target to raise £2,063 to go towards the **British Skin Foundation's It Takes 7** skin cancer campaign.

Despite numerous setbacks, including Hayley's severe whiplash from a car accident and back problems for Colin, the two completed the challenge with great determination.

Colin, 50, says, "It was a much harder challenge that I had imagined, but I just kept in mind all those suffering with skin cancer and that spurred me on to complete the challenge."

Hayley, 25, agreed, "It was very tough but totally worth it. Skin cancer is a serious disease and it was great to be able to help fight it."

All of the money they raised will go towards skin cancer research, helping to fight a disease that kills seven people a day in the UK alone.
